BIG CREEK TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 9

Adopted by the Township Board of the Township of Big Creek, Oscoda County, Michigan, on the 17th day of August, 1981.

SECTION 1. UNLAWFUL ACTS. The Township Board for the Township of Big Creek, Oscoda County, Michigan, hereby ordains that it shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to walk on any State highway or County road within the Township of Big Creek, Oscoda County, where there is a sidewalk provided for that pedestrian to walk upon.

SECTION 2. ENFORCEMENT. The authority to enforce Big Creek Township Ordinance No. 9 is hereby given to the Oscoda County Sheriff Department.

SECTION 3. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES. Any pedestrian who refuses to comply with this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Upon conviction thereof, he shall be punished by a fine not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any action, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication.
